1. What Are Cookies?

Cookies are small text files stored on your device when you visit a website. They help us enhance your browsing experience and analyze website traffic.

2. What types of Cookies do we use?

- a) Essential Cookies: We use technical Cookies and other Trackers to carry out activities that are strictly necessary for the operation, delivery of the Service and website functionality.
- b) Analysis cookies: These allow us to track and analyze the behavior of the users of the Site and to understand how visitors use our site, in order for us to further improve the services provided by our website.
- c) Measurement Cookies: We use cookies that allow us to measure traffic on our site in order to improve our customers' experience.
- d) Marketing Cookies: Only with your consent, we use Trackers to show you personalized advertisements.

3. How to manage your Cookies Preferences?
